

Programs of Support for Students Who Struggle

Office Hours: All Rosary Academy teachers have weekly office hours when they are available to provide extra support to struggling students. In addition, Rosary schedules office hours during “Flex” periods where students must work in a particular classroom.

National Honor Society Tutoring: Peer-to-peer tutoring is provided by National Honor Society students.

Summer School Remediation: Academic remediation is available during summer school. Academic remediation is required for any students who receive a failing grade in a class.

Referral to the Rosary Support Program: Teachers and parents of struggling students who suspect a learning difference can be referred to the RSP staff, who can then observe the student in class and offer suggestions moving forward.

Learning Strategies Course: The purpose of this course is to enable students to acquire and generalize strategies and skills across academic and community settings to achieve annual goals based on assessed needs. This course is designed for students who need individualized intervention in learning strategies. The course may address academic skill deficits enabling students to learn strategies to access the general curriculum and close educational gaps.

A student may repeat this course. The particular course requirements that the student should master each year must be specified on an individual basis and relate to achievement of annual goals. Instruction in subsequent courses should be designed to build upon students’ previously mastered skills, not repeat previous course content.
